# 21/057 Presentation by Jonathan Evison, Humberside Police & Crime Commissioner

The Mayor introduced Jonathan Evison, the new Humberside Police and Crime Commissioner.

Mr Evison outlined his plans for the next 3 years of his tenure to tackle anti-social behaviour through the Community Safety Partnership, primarily targeting drug crime that is a cause of many related "minor" crimes.

Operation Galaxy has already made many arrests, through County Lines intelligence. His plans are to tackle Violence Against Women and Girls (VAWG) in the home and on the streets, already receiving nearly £400,000 funding from the government for this. The PCC confirm ed there is to be a new school engagement program.

Cllr Waltham thanked the Police for their positive presence during the Brigg unofficial horse fair in August 2021.

Editor of Brigg Matters offered a page in Brigg Matters for the PCC to post an article at no cost.
