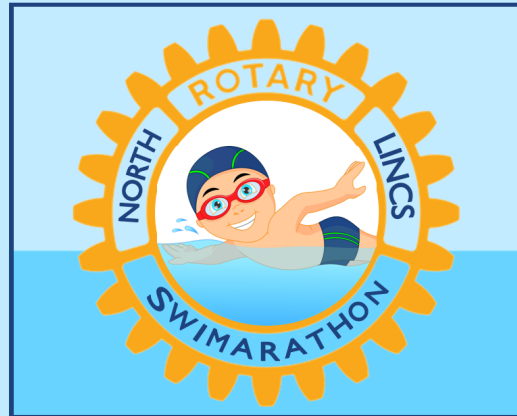

How does it work?

- Teams of six swimmers book a lane to use on the day and will have 50 minutes to swim as many lengths as they can as a relay—one swimmer / one length at a time. No age or ability restrictions; you just need to be a safe swimmer!
- **The members of the team find their own sponsors and pledge whatever they can: there is no entry fee and no minimum pledge!**
- **Members collect-in their sponsorship money and donate it to the Swimarathon Charity Fund.**
- **Every team participating will receive a photograph / “Certificate of Thanks” quoting the amount that they pledged.**

What happens to the money that you raise?

- **Every single penny that you raise will be added to the money raised by other Swimarathon teams.**
- **The combined Rotary Clubs of Brigg, Scunthorpe & Scunthorpe Pentagon will distribute all the money to LOCAL charities and good causes within North Lincolnshire.**
- **LOCAL charities / community causes can apply to receive an award under the Swimarathon Charity Fund scheme following the event.**
- **The funds will be donated to successful applicants by the three combined Local Rotary Clubs at a public event in June 2018.**

We aim for this to become an annual event; you could get involved from the start!
